

Community Survey Analysis

This survey was distributed to 190 houses in the village and immediate vicinity of Hayscastle Cross. 130 responses were returned. The survey sought feedback to what the community wanted from the pub and the appetite for funding it through share ownership.

Key highlights

62% would attend a community Christmas meal.

60% responded favourably to a café morning with shop, mobile PO and library.

58% responded positively to a mid-week lunch club.

57% would support a book swap club.

48% would attend a mid-week walk and coffee.

46% would consider buying shares with 8% unsure.

Other free format responses

- A take-away service was a popular suggestion following the success during lockdown and that no takeaway service is currently available in the village.
- Dish of the Day – fixed price affordable menu options
- Improve the quality of the food.
- To host events such as music, quiz, bingo, beer festivals, themed nights, Christmas/Halloween parties, cocktail nights.
- Host activities to encourage those that are working and younger sections of the community
- A daytime café facility to become the hub for various groups.
- Will the venue be wheelchair accessible?
- Loyalty discount scheme
- Arts, craft and literary book swap groups
- Learning and support groups – IT help, Welsh language, 'Repair Shop' days
- Prescription collection
- EV Charging facilities
- Community Noticeboard to share news, events and promote local trades and services.
