Pub Management

We had initially hoped to recruit a Pub Manager. Several applications were received, 2 offers were made but sadly

both were turned down on personal grounds. As a result, the Board reviewed the situation and decided to implement a different strategy.

Overall running of the pub is now undertaken by an operations team working with the employed staff. This was the approach adopted in the interim period when there was no Pub Manager and as this was felt to be working well, it was agreed to continue with this operating model.

The downstairs area of the pub including the kitchen and dining area is now fully operational. There is now disabled access from the car park.
